Local/National Innovation Initiatives

National Level Innovation in Patient Safety and Quality – The focus of the project/initiative extends beyond local areas to implementation across the country to achieve national impact.

Local Level Innovation in Patient Safety and Quality – The project/initiative focuses on effecting impact at the local community, organizational or regional level (e.g., statewide).

- Applicants must be United States-based (including US Territories and military bases).
- Health care organizations applying that operate in settings for which Joint Commission has accreditation/certification programs must be accredited/certified by The Joint Commission to be eligible.
- **Initiatives must have 12 months of sustainment data to be eligible.**
- Application period is February 4 to March 31 at 11:59 p.m. CT.

- Describe why the focus area for your initiative is/was important for patient safety and quality. (1,250 character limit, including spaces; approximately 1/2 single-spaced page)
- Describe how the problem was identified within your setting/organization. (1,250 character limit, including spaces; approximately 1/2 single-spaced page).
- Explain how the project/initiative was implemented. (2,500 character limit, including spaces; approximately 1 single-spaced page).
- Describe your achievements and improved state. (1,250 character limit, including spaces; approximately 1/2 single-spaced page)
- Describe how the project/initiative represents an innovation or novel approach. (2,500 character limit, including spaces; approximately 1 single-spaced page)
- How do you monitor that the improvement is sustained? (1,250 character limit, including spaces; approximately 1/2 single-spaced page). All improvements must have been sustained for 12 months and applicants should include most recent available data.
- Describe how the project/initiative has been or could be replicated across departments or organizations. Share experiences or suggestions on how others could implement. (1,250 character limit, including spaces; approximately 1/2 single-spaced page).

- Applicants can upload a supplemental document of up to 7 pages of tables and/or figures. Applicants must reference each figure/table within their narrative responses to link the information.
