Unresolved	ePC01	Value Set	In April 2025, CMS implemented additional ICD-10-PCS codes applicable for the 2025 reporting year, including "0U7C7DJ- Dilation of Cervix with Intraluminal Device, Temporary, Via Natural or Artificial Opening" that applies to value set "Medical Induction of Labor" (2.16.840.1.113883.3.117.1.7.1.288 ). Currently, the Value Set Authority Center will not update available ICD-10 codes with the April 2025 release in time, so the code will not be included in the 2026RY measure specifications.	Potential impact of not capturing the new ICD-10-PCS code for medical induction of labor for the measure.	Consider temporarily mapping your local terminology and/or the ICD-10-PCS code to an existing SNOMED code within the value set such as "31208007 Medical induction of labor" until the next Annual Update, when the codes will be available in the Value Set Authority Center to apply to the value set.
